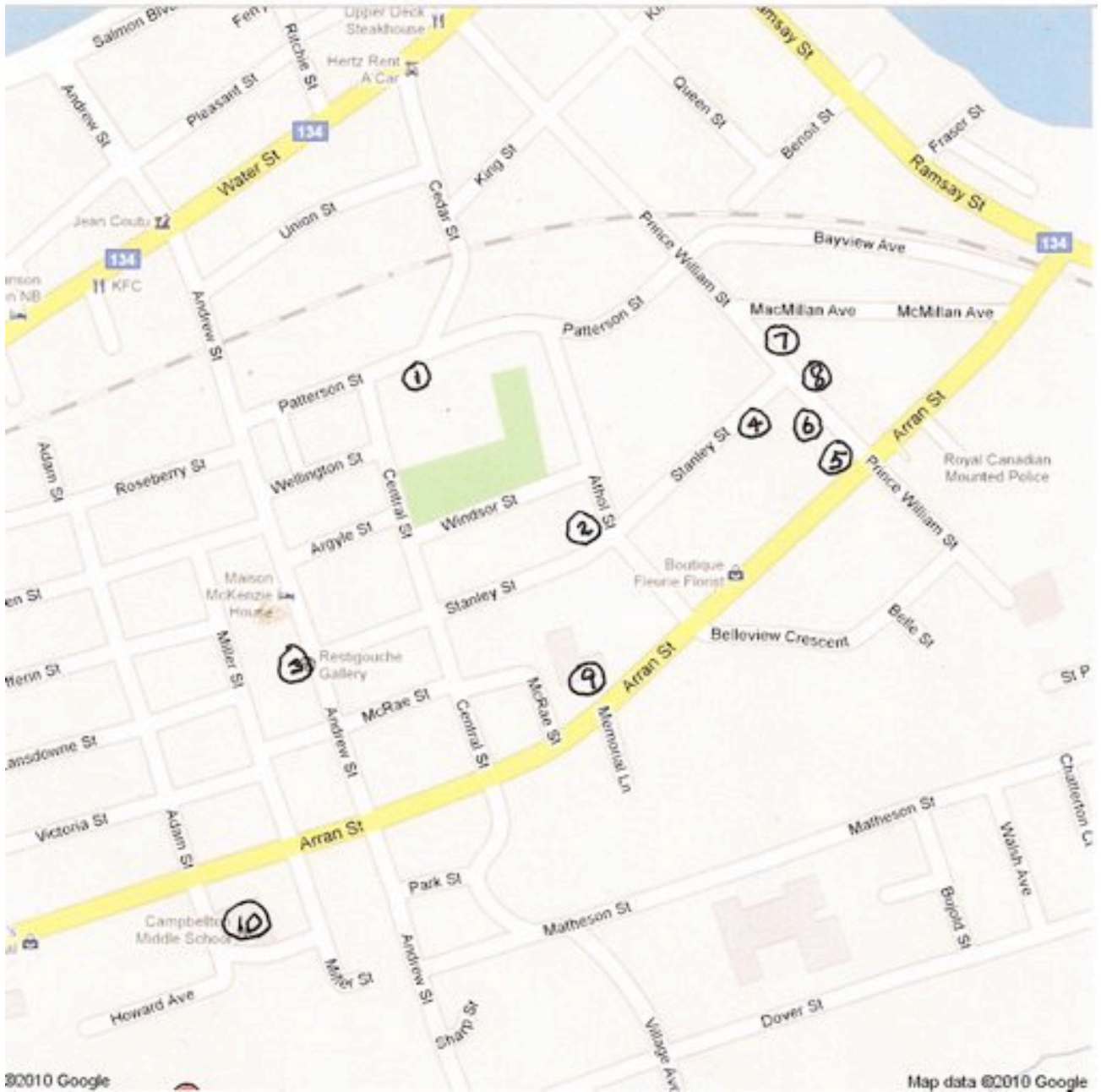


MOWATS IN CAMPBELLTON 1920 - 50



1. Champoux house was a large house with coach house we rented from 1930 when I was 5 years old until the tornado in 1935 damaged it so much we had to move.
2. My father bought a beautiful big house at the top of the Stanley Street hill [#13] built by my Uncle Jack Wyers. I lived there until I left home for good in 1946
3. Grammar school where I attended Grades 1 through 8.
4. #2 Stanley St. – a house built by Aunt Bertha and her husband. When they left Campbellton in 1932 Uncle Earl and Aunt Nan and family lived there.
5. Big house - Great Uncle Max and family lived in it I think until he died in 1959.
6. Goo Mowat's house – mother's 1st cousin, I always referred to him as Uncle Goog.
7. Uncle Jack's house – Allan grew up there
8. Muriel & Hugh's big house – Referred to them as Aunt and Uncle – Muriel was mother's 1st cousin
9. Soldier's Memorial Hospital where I was born in 1925.
10. Campbellton High School where I went to school from Grade 9 to 11 when I graduated.

I knew everyone on Stanley St. from Athol to Pr. William St. and everyone on Athol from Stanley to Patterson.
